

MARCH LABOR REPORT RECAP

According to the recent jobs report from the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the labor market is still growing, with 236,000 nonfarm payroll jobs added in March 2023, a decrease of 75,000 jobs compared to last month. The unemployment rate also decreased to 3.5 percent from 3.6 percent in February.


